



2023 Fans Guide

Here is some important information to help you enjoy your Lancaster Sound Breakers Fan experience.

Forms of Payment: Cash, and Credit Cards are accepted for ticket purchases and merchandise sales.

The Lancaster Sound Breakers are members of the Pacific Division of the Pecos League. The Pecos League is an independent league. The Sound Breakers are not a major league affiliated and do not receive funding from an affiliate.

Parking is \$5 and payable via cash, it is ran by various service clubs.

Ticket Pricing: Individual tickets \$10 general admission – (groups must purchase in advance or contact General Manager to schedule group night. **Children** 6 years of age and older require a ticket to enter the ballpark, children 5 and under are free.

Reserved Seating- The Sound Breakers sell reserved seating to games up until 10PM the night before the game.

Beverages, Food & Containers: No bottles, cans, beverages, or containers may be brought into the Hangar.

Backpacks and Other Bags: All bags are subject to search upon entry. Prohibited items will not be allowed inside the ballpark (see “*other prohibited items*” for more information).

Alcohol Management: Alcohol will be sold each night of the 2023. No alcoholic beverages may be brought into or removed from the Hangar. California State Law prohibits the sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under the age of 21.

Please note the following policies:

- -Patrons will be required to show proper proof of age when purchasing alcoholic beverages at The Hangar.
- -California Law prohibits patrons from purchasing and/or possessing more than two alcoholic beverages at a time.
- -Alcohol will not be served after the bottom of the 7th inning or 9pm, whichever comes first.
- -The Lancaster Sound Breakers reserves the right to deny the sale of alcoholic beverages to any guests.
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Fans Code of Conduct: The Lancaster Sound Breakers are committed to creating a safe, comfortable, and enjoyable experience for our guests at the Hangar. Our staff will proactively intervene to support an environment their guests can enjoy experience free of unacceptable behavior, including the following:

Autograph Requests: Guests may make autograph requests from the players/coaches and visiting teams up to 15 minutes prior to game time and immediately following end of game.

Field Trespassing: Any guest attempting to enter the field of play before, during or after an event without authorization will be removed from the stadium and subject to criminal prosecution and/or fines.

Kids Run: Kids from 0 – 100 have the opportunity to run the bases in the middle of the 3rd inning (subject to change or cancellation). Kids enter the field on the 1st base side, lining up at the fence near the home team dugout at the beginning of the inning.

National Anthem Performance: Those wishing to perform the National Anthem at a game may submit a request to the General Manager.

Pets & Service Animals: Pets, and service animals, must be accompanied by the handler and always leashed, handler is responsible for cleaning up after pets. *Unruly or aggressive animals may be required to leave at the discretion of the Fuego management.*

Pass the Hat: Bring your Dollar bills!!! Pass the hat is an old-time baseball tradition offering player incentive when home team players perform outstanding plays by collecting cash from fans. Santa Fe Fuego staff will pass the hat for every home team homerun, pitcher that strikes out the side, pitcher who pitches seven full innings, pitches full game and other outstanding plays.
